Relationships and Sex Education Consultation

From Care: 'In December the Government published an 8 week consultation on the teaching of Relationships and Sex Education in England. This follows a vote in March in which Parliament decided to make relationships education mandatory for all children in England from 5 years of age without a parental right of withdrawal; a change that requires further legislation before it can come into effect. This is a crucial consultation which has two parts: one for adults, the other for young people. We will provide you with a supporter briefing to help you respond in the New Year. 
