

We went on to cross the border into Wales, where we eventually parked up at the Broughton Retail Park, in Broughton, Flintshire. We decided to have 'brunch' at a well-known, national cafe chain. I joined the queue, with a tray, as my manager went and sat down, inside. Soon, I was being asked by the woman behind the counter, what drinks I was ordering. I responded in my normal, friendly way and then asked her, how her morning was going. She looked straight at me, laughed and said something along the lines of, don't ask! We went on to laugh and joke about how busy it was there. Eventually, my order was ready and I chose to pay by cash. In giving me my change, I said to her, "Thanks - God bless."


Finance
