Minister's Letter

At the time of writing, Fiona and I are starting to prepare for a week's holiday, our first since 2019.

Before then, my Annual Leave would allow me to go off with Fiona to do radio work; most memorably twice in Derry in Northern Ireland. On one occasion, I sat in someone's living-room in the Bogside area, looking out onto the site of the Bloody Sunday atrocity, interviewing two innocent people who had witnessed the massacre, that day. On the other, I sat in the living-room of the sister of the first child-fatality of The Troubles.

For years Fiona and I spent our holidays sharing the driving from Southend to Merseyside, where we would visit her family, there.

Before then, as a single man, employed by H.M. Customs and Excise, I'd take my Annual Leave in odd days, here-and-there, in doing voluntary work. Whilst my mates were imploring me to join them in boozy breaks on the Costa Packet, I'd instead take two or three senior citizens in the back of my dad's car for a drive along Southend seafront, where I'd eventually park-up and treat them to lunch at a cafe. For some of them, it was one of the few times that they'd go out, all month. I also remember taking odd days off, to help Refugees from Kosovo and Zimbabwe.

However, you choose to holiday, don't be afraid to witness to the God who gave us holy days in the first place. When I pray for opportunities to do, they do come along! Yes, rest and relax; however, be aware that other people - outside of their usual routines and surroundings, themselves - may let their guard down and just be open to chatting about the Jesus that you follow. You may never see them again, but do share with them, something that they'll never forget.
