Soaking in the Word

Acts 2 v 1-4 Amplified Bible - The Day of Pentecost

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place, and suddenly a sound came from heaven like a rushing violent wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. There appeared to them tongues resembling fire, which were being distributed [among them], and they rested on each one of them [as each person received the Holy Spirit]. And they were all filled [that is, diffused throughout their being] with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues (different languages), as the Spirit was giving them the ability to speak out [clearly and appropriately].`

Points to Ponder

- When we release the situation to God, he will take care of it and do what he needs to.
- God made you a dwelling place for his power and grace.
- Let your heart burn with his love, sing out hallelujah.
- Take every thought captive and make it obedient to Christ. 2 Cor 10: 5

Forgiveness Questions and responses

Do you need to ask for God's forgiveness for anything?

But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. (1 John 1 v 9)

- Ask Holy Spirit to bring to your mind things that you may need forgiveness
- Focus on the Cross and what Jesus did for you
- Confess your sin quietly to God
- Receive the Forgiveness flowing freely from God.
- Move forward to live in Freedom

Have you asked God for forgiveness but you are struggling to forgive yourself?

God says that He will throw the sins of His people into the depths of the sea. (Micah 7:19)

He has removed our sins as far from us as the east is from the west. (Psalm 103:2)

- Ask Holy Spirit to bring to your mind things that you are still holding onto
- Read the scriptures above and realise that you are forgiven
- Decide to forgive yourself – God loves you and has forgiven you
- Let that sink in
- Receive the unconditional love flowing freely from God.
- Move forward lighter to live out your Freedom and not be held back anymore.
